





President's Message



Discussions have started about the Holiday of Trees at NWSB Bank, *A Division of ACNB Bank*. Stay tuned for more information as this annual event takes shape.


My continued thanks to all our volunteers. Your support is precious and irreplaceable. And thank you to our board of directors and many committee members. I am grateful for your good work.

2021 Fall Programs

On **Saturday, September 11**, T.H.M.A. is hosting a **19th Century Base Ball tournament** between the Keystone Baseball Club of Harrisburg and the Chesapeake Nine of Baltimore on the Northwest Middle School property along Merwyn Drive in Taneytown. The tournament starts at 10:30 a.m. with a discussion of the rules of baseball in 1863. The first game starts at 11 a.m. The second game will start at 1:30 p.m. and end around 3:30 p.m. The league plays base ball utilizing the equipment, uniforms, rules, and terminology that was current in the early to mid-1860's.

The fall T.H.M.A. meeting series begins **Monday, September 27** • 7 p.m. at Trinity Lutheran Church, 38 W. Baltimore St., Taneytown, MD. Following a brief business meeting our guest speaker will be Rich Heinick of the Keystone Baseball Club of Harrisburg. Rich will be speaking about baseball's evolution from the beginnings to our current game. In addition, he will speak about how the 19th Century Base Ball League got its beginnings.
