

What's going on at the Museum?



I'm happy to report the heating/air conditioning unit, we ordered in February, will be installed in the garage on September 2, 2022, just in time to host the Taneytown Chamber of Commerce on September 22. We have been working on upgrading the garage to host events and to stage large groups with light refreshments and conversation while they wait to tour the museum in manageable smaller groups. Currently window frames are being trimmed and curtains added to make it more appealing.

We have started looking at dealing with the aging rear deck and the maintenance thereof by contracting Dean Robert Camlin & Associates to design a much smaller low maintenance replacement deck. This may also allow us to move the end of the accessibility ramp farther from the garage allowing easier car passage between ramp and garage.

We are also looking at ways to increase attendance of visitors to see our wonderful
